Athanasios Moysiadis studied Surveying at the Technological Educational Institute (TEI) of Athens. He also holds a Competency Degree in Pedagogic and Education from the School of Pedagogical & Technological Education/ASPETE, a Master of Science in Photogrammetry with Remote Sensing from the University of London (U.C.L.) (scholarship from the Greek Foundation of Scholarships) and a Doctor of Philosophy in Surveying and Geomatics from the University of Thessaly (two times scholarship according to publications).

Since 2006 he works as an Adjunct Professor at the Technological Educational Institute (TEI) of Thessaly. Since 2008 he works as a researcher in applications of natural and cultural heritage by means of surveying and geomatics and as an Adjunct Professor at the Undergraduate Program of Studies and at the Franco Hellenic Postgraduate Program of Studies of the Department of Planning and Regional Development of the School of Engineering of the University of Thessaly. He has also worked as a free-lance surveyor mainly in research programs of Universities Dioceses and Development Agencies.

He has published at international peer reviewed scientific journals, proceedings of national and international conferences, collective volumes, while he has participated as a member of organising and scientific committees at international conferences.

He is the editor of the scientific newsletters of the European Association of Remote Sensing Laboratories/EARSeL, the International Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing/ISPRS. He is also the creator and the editor of the blog of the International Society for Digital Earth, China.

He is also a member of the Scientific Committee of Cultural Heritage at the International Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing/ISPRS, the Remote Sensing and Photogrammetry Society/RSPSoc and the Special Committees of Geometric Documentation of Cultural Heritage/CIPA of ICOMOS, under the aegis of UNESCO.
